Dear Gibson County Commissioners:

You will be receiving various overnight deliveries that together will constitute the Application for a Permit (“Application”) for Gibson Solar, LLC (the “Project”). We also provide you this link to the [Project data room](#).

These submittals summarized below as set out in the County Solar Energy Project Ordinance (“Ordinance”), represent in the experience of Arevon Energy, Inc. and Tenaska best practice approaches to the required submittals which we believe together constitute a complete filing under the SECS provisions of the Ordinance.

Based on your receipt on November 12, 2021, we ask that you evaluate the Application and respond back to us with initial comments on completeness by December 1, 2021, and, assuming compliance with the application requirements, issue a permit by December 27, 2021.
